
## International Wire Instructions

<u>FUNDS BEING WIRED INTO A BEEHIVE ACCOUNT:</u> If you wire funds **to Beehive from an international location**, you will need to have the sending site use a FOREIGN FINANCIAL CORRESPONDENT BANK.

Beehive Federal Credit Union **does not use an international SWIFT code** for incoming wired funds. SWIFT codes are used when funds are being transferred between countries. Since an intermediary/correspondent US bank is needed to first get the funds into the US, no SWIFT code is necessary for the transfer to the Beehive FCU account. \*Contact your sending location if more information is needed.\* Use the instructions below to complete the funds wire transfer:

<u>FUNDS BEING WIRED FROM A BEEHIVE ACCOUNT:</u> If you wire funds **from a Beehive account to an international location, contact the receiving institution for instructions**. These instructions should include a SWIFT Code, since money is being transferred between countries.

It is common for international wire transfers to use an intermediary/correspondent US bank as a "middle man" for funds wire transfers. Information for all financial institutions involved is needed before money can be wired out.
